

## APPLICATION DOCUMENTS - BACHELOR'S PROGRAM

You are interested in a scholarship from SOS-Kinderdörfer weltweit (SOS-Kinderdörfer) for your Bachelor's program. The additional documents you need to enclose with your application are listed below. Please also check the general application criteria under "How to apply".

- 1. An acceptance letter from a university in your country.
- 2. Copies of all your transcripts from high school.
  - o This is a document which lists all the grades which you got in high school.
- 3. A high school leaving certificate or diploma.
- 4. You have recommendation letters from at least 2 SOS Co-workers on SOS letterhead.
  - The letters should explain how each co-worker knows you and for how long they have known you.
  - o The letters should also show which SOS program you are from and how long you have been a part of the SOS program.
  - The letters should also explain why the co-workers think you are a great candidate to get a scholarship from SOS-Kinderdörfer weltweit.
- 5. A motivational letter which explains why you wish to study the specific program at that specific university and how this will contribute to your future career plans and goals.
- 6. The filled-out **costs spreadsheet** with an estimate of how much your studies will cost in total.
  - Please download the Excel file labelled "Cost spreadsheet" on the page "Learn with us" to fill out your estimate of the costs associated with your studies for the entire duration of study.
  - The maximum amount a student can be supported with to cover all costs is the equivalent of 15.000 USD per year, but the disbursements for each year are subject to SOS-Kinderdörfer's income and the favorable decision of SOS-Kinderdörfer's Supervisory Board on SOS-Kinderdörfer's budget.

7. An up-to-date resume or CV.

A copy of your passport or national ID.
